Dubois, WY - The weekend of February 4th - 6th brings the Dubois Winterfest and the 14th Annual Dubois Sled Dog & Skijoring Races with activities scheduled for the entire family. Whether you enjoy outdoor winter activities or prefer indoor festivities, we have something entertaining for everyone this weekend.

Saturday's events start at 8:30 a.m. with the first round of sled dog races held at the Sheridan Creek Oval (approximately 17 miles west of Dubois). Events taking place in town that day include the children's "Warm Up!" Crafts at the Bighorn Sheep Center at 10 a.m. where children will make a hat and scarf, a Bread & Soup Contest at the Headwaters from 1-3 p.m., Dress Up Show for Kids at the Headwaters at 2 p.m. and the festivities conclude in the evening with a Hootenanny at 7 p.m.

Sunday at 9 a.m. at the Sheridan Creek Oval the second and final round of Sled Dog & Skijoring Races begin. Snowshoe Mania, held from 9-10:30 a.m. is a chance for children 9+ years and adults to try snowshoeing (snowshoes provided). The culminating outdoor event of the day is the Pee Wee Fun Run (one sled and one dog)



for kids ages 3 through 8, scheduled for approximately 12:30 pm. All events are FREE except the Bread and Soup contest which is \$1 per ballot.
