With over a million active caches world wide, the game is played by high-tech, adventure seekers with GPS devices or GPS-equipped mobile phone devices. The basic idea is to locate hidden containers, called geocaches, by following the coordinates on your GPS. This can take you into beautiful hiking locations and even suburban areas. In the Fremont County zip code areas, there are over 200 caches to find!



Once close to the coordinates, you will look for the cache in the vicinity. You may need to be creative in your search. Many times the caches are cleverly hidden. When the container is located, you may take something out and replace it with something of equal or lesser value. Just imagine where this could take you! Whether you are a tourist or resident, this is a great way
